

As a single parent, paying for school can be difficult. Women's Services and Resources has scholarships available to ease the burdens many single parents face when trying to balance school, work, child care, and paying the bills.

Who can apply for a single parent scholarship through Women's Services and Resources?

Single parent scholarships, available through Women's Services and Resources (WSR), are reserved for single parents with one or more dependent children in the home. Students who come from single parent homes but are not single parents themselves are not eligible for these scholarships at this time.

How can I apply for a WSR single parent scholarship?

Scholarship applications are available online at wsr.byu.edu. As part of the application, you will submit a personal statement explaining your situation and financial need; instructions are included on the scholarship application. Once your application is complete, it can be emailed to wsr@byu.edu or a printed copy may be delivered to the WSR office.

Are there admission or grade requirements for WSR single parent scholarships?

Students must be accepted to BYU in order to apply. Those who are selected for a scholarship will be required to maintain satisfactory progress toward graduation. While there is not a specific grade point requirement, recipients will be required to meet once during the semester with the Women's Services and Resources director to evaluate progress and additional needs.

What is the application deadline for WSR single parent scholarships?

Unlike university scholarships, department scholarships may be administered in a more flexible manner. Please visit the WSR website for current deadlines. Awards are typically made in April for fall semester, October for winter semester, and March for spring and summer terms.

How will I know if I was selected for a WSR single parent scholarship?

Applicants will be notified within 30 days of the receipt of their completed application.
